



Patrol Knife Tactics Course

This 2-day (16 hour) course was developed specifically for law enforcement officers. The purpose of this training is to increase awareness of edge weapons and to familiarize officers on the every day carry (EDC) tactical folder. The training will cover the knife both as a utility tool and as a defensive/offensive edge weapon. Due to the depth of information regarding knives and their use, this course will focus on realistic and reliable EDC tactical folder options. We find that Body Mechanics & Distance Management almost every officer carries some type of knife in the field, but most have never had any training on the practical application of this tool. This course will meet that need and give a useful understanding of both civil and criminal aspects. This is training that is missed in most agencies, but not anymore.
